

Ashbourne Touring and Camping Park - Park Rules

Touring and Seasonal Pitches

- We have grass and hardstanding pitches. Use of an awning on a hard-standing pitch must be within the designated area of the pitch, not on the grass in-between, which is the 6 metre fire gap. A breathable ground sheet is required with an awning for the grass pitches.
- The speed limit is 5 mph on the park, please respect this for the safety of all site users.
- Visitors are very welcome. Only 1 car is permitted on the pitch therefore all visitors must report to reception before entering the park so they can be advised where to park.
- All male or all female parties will be accommodated at the discretion of the managers.
- Dogs are accepted, but must be kept on a lead at all times and not left unattended in the tourers. You are required to clean up after your dog and place in the bins provided. Maximum 2 dogs per tourer.
- Gazebos, wind breaks, washing lines, tents of any description & Generators are not permitted on site.
- We do allow tents in the grass field only.
- BBQ's are permitted but must be raised from floor level so not to cause damage and burn the grass.
- The lighting of fires outside the tourer or anywhere on the park is not permitted, this includes fire pits.
- We only allow professionally converted Registered Motorhomes at Ashbourne Touring Park. Vans, commercial vehicles or sign written vehicles are not permitted on site, if you use one as a tow vehicle you can come onto the park with it but it will need to be parked elsewhere.
- This is a quiet countryside park, so please respect the privacy of other holiday makers and keep noise level to a minimum between 11.00 pm and 8.00 am
- Children are the responsibility of their parents or guardians and are to be supervised at all times.
- The use of children's bicycles, scooters, remote cars, ball games are not permitted around the caravans or toilet block.
- Bathing and swimming is not allowed in the ponds.
- We are a holiday park and as such cannot be used as a base to travel to and from work on a regular basis.
- Fireworks and Firearms are not permitted on the park.
- Use of unlawful drugs is not permitted and is a criminal offence.
- We are entitled to evict anyone from the park who persistently acts in a manner which is likely to upset or annoy other users of the park or our staff or who is guilty of a criminal offence.
- Any payment made to the site deems you accept the parks rules and adhere to site regulations.
- The park owners do not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to private property or persons using the park.
- We advise that your caravan/motorhome be fully insured as no responsibility can be accepted by the company for loss or damage whilst on site.
- The Managers decision is final on all park issues.

- Your pitch must be kept tidy at all times and the grass kept free of water barrels and belongings when you are not using the caravan to allow for grass cutting.
- Overnight visitors are not permitted to erect a tent or stay in a vehicle overnight next to your caravan, they must stay on a designated pitch at a cost agreed by the manager.

Rally Terms and Conditions

- To constitute a Rally there must be a minimum of 10 units attending and you must be a registered club holding a valid exemption certificate. If you fail to reach this amount the units attending will be charged at the applicable nightly rate of the site.
- One free place will be given for a steward on groups between 10 and 20 paying units.
- Two free places will be given for two stewards for groups of over 20 paying units.
- We allow the stewards to arrive on site the day before the rally and stay on site for 1 night at the end of the rally to clear up if required.
- Use of the toilet and shower block the cost of using these facilities is included within the pitch per night cost. These facilities are also used by our seasonal pitches so we request they are left in good order and any issues are reported to the Park Manager.
- Please ensure that the Rally Stewards are here and ready for the arrival of their members and that your Rally signs are sufficiently displayed. Arrival onto the Rally should be no earlier than 10am or the official start time of your Rally and the latest arrival time is 8pm or dusk (whichever is the earliest). Anyone arriving after this time will not be permitted on park.
- As per our site rules Windbreaks, Gazebo's, Washing lines, Generators and Commercial Vehicles are not permitted on site.
- All pitching on the Rally field MUST conform to safety standards, please see advisory notes in your rally pack.
- Dogs are permitted on site, maximum of 2 dogs per unit.
- Rallies must conform to Ashbourne Park Ltd site rule at all times
